## PLEASE READ Important Information Regarding the Harrow Half Marathon 2019

We are writing to inform you that the Harrow Half Marathon will be taking place on Sunday 15<sup>h</sup> September 2019.

As a result of this, vehicular access to your property will be restricted and we ask that, unless you really need to, journeys are postponed and vehicles parked away from the restrictions.

Pinner Road, Marsh Road and Bridge Street will be closed eastbound (even number side) between Love Lane and Headstone Lane from 4am to 11.30am on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Parking restrictions will also be in place on both sides of the roads between these points and these will be in place from midday on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2019. If you require access to your vehicle and live in one of the even numbered properties on Pinner Road or Marsh Road you should make alternate parking arrangements.

Properties in School Lane, Cecil Park, Capel Gardens, Pinner Court and the Fire Brigade cottages will be provided access via marshal control but this will be restricted between runners and exiting vehicles will only be permitted to turn right towards Pinner. Alternative roads such as Rayners Lane and Eastcote Road can be used to reach onwards destinations.

Any vehicle parked in contravention of the restrictions will be removed




